Angola Spring Rodeo

Twice a year, spectators come from miles around to the Angola Prison Rodeo for white-knuckled bull riding, bronco riding, barrel racing, steer wrestling, and a variety of events you won't see anywhere else on the planet, like Convict Poker. Watch four offenders play poker seated at a table with a loose bull—the last seated man wins! Safety protocols are in place, and the event raises funds for inmate welfare.
