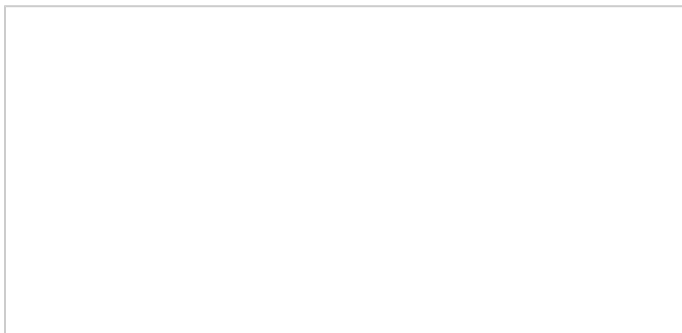

Oak Alley Plantation Hours and Admission



[Oak Alley Plantation](#) in Vacherie, Louisiana sprawls along the banks of the Mississippi River. Designated a National Historic Landmark, knowledgeable historical interpreters paint a picture of life for the free and enslaved men, women, and children who once resided here. Guides also share the story of the



land itself from being a sugar plantation, investment property, and cattle ranch to the present-day historic site that's dedicated to preserving the past.

Whether you tour the antebellum mansion and poignant slavery exhibit on a day trip or stay overnight at the Oak Alley Plantation Restaurant & Inn, the plantation is a significant destination that sheds light on the realities of the past.

Planning Your Visit to Oak Alley Plantation

- We recommend purchasing [Oak Alley Plantation tickets online](#) in advance.
- Arrive at the ticket booth 30 minutes prior to your "Big House" tour and allow 30 minutes for the guided mansion tour.
- The historic site is entirely accessible except for the 2nd floor of the "Big House". A video tour is available for guests who are unable to climb the 22 stairs to the upper floor.

- Allow at least 2 hours for the self-guided tour of the plantation grounds, slavery exhibit, as well as various other exhibits and points of interest.
- Service animals are permitted, but pets are not allowed on the property.
